The membership of the Plymouth County League of Sportsmen voted to donate \$300 to MassWildlife's Hunters Share the Harvest program. This is a new program started right here in Plymouth County. The program provides an opportunity for hunters to donate and share wild game meat like venison with Massachusetts residents in need. We are proud that local hunters donated over a dozen deer to help feed the needy. The fact that this program just started and had not been widely advertised in advanced indicates the degree of support from the local sporting community. A [recent study by The Greater Boston Food Bank](#) shows that nearly one-third of adults in Massachusetts are facing food insecurity, a number that has grown during the pandemic.
