values to the next generation. Mention a positive role model in your life who was a hunter.

Your letter need not be long nor professionally written and it does not have to be typed. It should come straight from your heart. Don't demand anything. Do ask that the committee find common ground and work on a solution that will put us on a path where Sunday hunting will become a reality in this legislative session. The time has come for a letter from you, then and only then will the time come for hunting on Sunday in Massachusetts.
