Free Saltwater Fishing Days: June 17 & 18

The weather is warming, the sun is shining, and the striped bass are plentiful! Fishing season is upon us! To get into the swing of it, Massachusetts is hosting its free saltwater fishing days on Father's Day weekend, June 17 and 18. So grab your rod, gather up the family, and head to the shoreline for some great fishing action. No need for a saltwater fishing permit in state marine waters, out to 3 miles, until the weekend is over.
